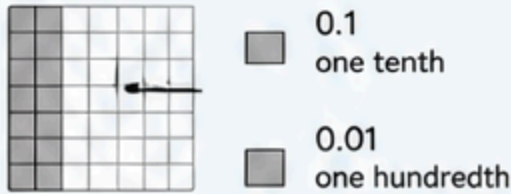


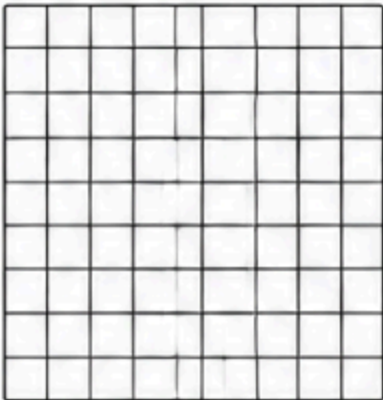
Shading Decimal Grids

Each column is one tenth (0.1). Each small square is one hundredth (0.01).

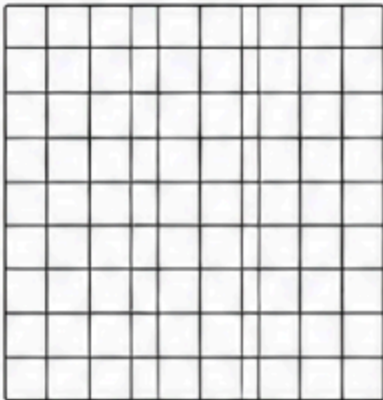


1. Shade each grid to show the decimal.

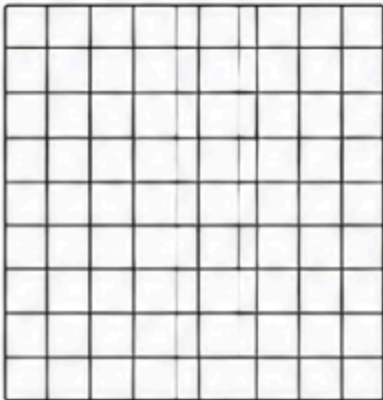

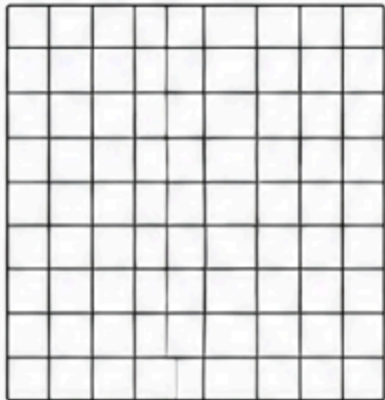

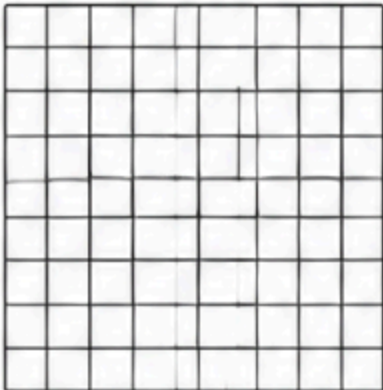

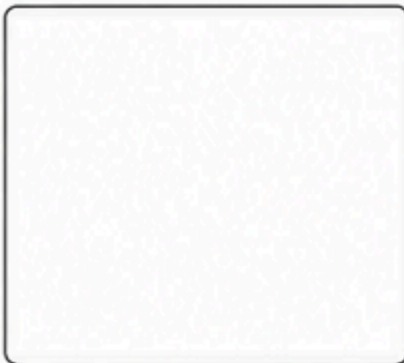
